

Objective: Students will demonstrate knowledge and current application of the roles of the President via Twitter.

Instructions: As you watch the State of the Union address, identify parts of the speech where the President illustrates each of the following roles:

1. Chief Executive
2. Chief Economic Planner
3. Commander in Chief
4. Head of State
5. Head of Party
6. Chief Diplomat
7. Chief Legislator

For each appropriate example, student will earn one point. Maximum of 15 points available.

Rules:

- Be as non-partisan as possible. Our job is to notice, not to judge.
- Be appropriate with your words, you represent my class and our school.
- Be as thorough as possible, this is a teaching moment for people reading!
- Be a good citizen of the Internet.
- Use #apschley19 #sotu as hashtags

Example:

@easchley: **Chief Legislator**- President Trump announces he will ask Congress for a law making National Pizza Day a federal holiday! #apschley19 #sotu

(This shows the role, the action that illustrates the role, is nonpartisan, and appropriate)

You will know that your tweet has been seen and is getting credit if Ms. Schley 'likes' the tweet.

Most importantly, have fun!
